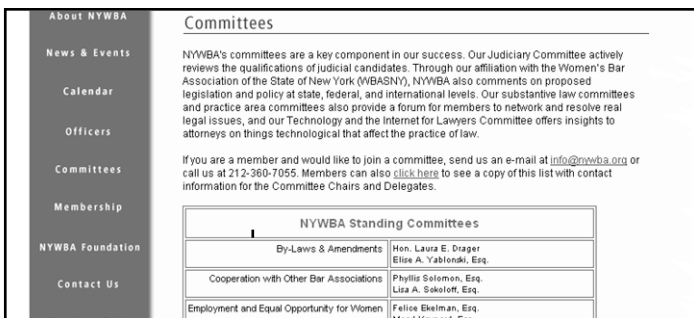


## Take a Tour of NYWBA's Website! NOTE: New Password for Members Only Pages

As announced in last month's Newsletter, effective March 1, 2005 we changed the password for our "members only" pages on the Association's website (<http://www.nywba.org>). This is the perfect opportunity to provide a brief description of key pages of the website. In the coming weeks, the site will be further enhanced by the addition of a new, more versatile calendar, as well as an automated membership form that will allow people to securely join or renew online. As those features are launched, we will announce them in the Newsletter, with a description and instructions on their use. In the meantime, take a "virtual tour" with us to see some of the benefits that our website already has to offer.

### Homepage

The homepage is the entrance to the website. It features the President's Message, a summary of the President's column in the NYWBA newsletter (linked to the full text of the column), and information about upcoming events. It also has a link to a list of our new members. You can also jump to the WBASNY site (<http://www.wbasny.org>) by clicking on the underlined word "WBASNY" above the President's Message. The column on the left, with the blue background, is a "navigation bar," which provides links to other areas of the NYWBA website. For convenient browsing, the bar appears on each page of the website.



### Committees

The Committees page lists all NYWBA committees (standing and special), as well as the WBASNY committees. The co-chairs and delegates for each committee are identified. Contact information is also available on this page, but it is hidden—you can access it only if you are a paid-up member and have the current password. (See description of "Members Only," below.) When a new committee forms, a co-chair changes, or we have other committee updates, the information quickly appears here.

### Members Only

Several sections of the website are available only to members, including contact information on the Committees page. You can also access the Members Only pages by selecting that link from the navigation bar at left. Members can view and print the entire newsletter (current and archived issues), and get contact information about committee chairs and officers, among other things. To access these pages, enter "nywba" as your user name and "equality" as the new password. (Access to the Members Only pages is a privilege of membership. Please do not share this information with non-members.)



### NYWBA Foundation

NYWBA Foundation, Inc. also has its own website (<http://www.nywbaf.org>), which you can access directly or from any page on the NYWBA site (through the navigation bar). Just click on "Foundation," and you will jump to the Foundation site, where you can find information about its important programs.
